**Northern Whisper Brewing Co:** Combining traditional brewing techniques with modern flavours.

**Pomona Island Brew Co:** Salford based brewery best known for experimental brews and sustainability.

**Wakey Wakey Brew Co:** Based at Rochdale's historic Flying Horse Hotel, offering traditional brewing with a contemporary twist.

There will also be a cider bar, and a gin bar.

Bury Beer Festival also features music from local DJs, a perfect accompaniment to this celebration of culture and innovation.
